« The author has considered seriously and well addressed the comments previously raised by the reviewers and the editor. The revised manuscript is significantly improved and I believe it will make a great contribution to the paleoclimate community. In particular, it is a good idea to add a table to give an overview of available softwares for insolation computations. As such a table is very interesting and useful, it would be more helpful and visible to the readers if it can appear in the main text. Therefore, I suggest to move the table from Appendix D to Introduction.
