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Thank you very much for your positive feedback and the helpful technical suggestions regarding our manuscript. Below are our point-by-point responses to the comments. The response is shown in red.

Abstract - a "the" before "Subglacial Lake Vostok region"

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L66 (track changes version) - "major" not "marjor"

Thank you for pointing this out. We have fixed this.

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L75-76 - This sentence should be reworded since "capturing" "capabilities" does not make much sense. Can "capabilities" be replaced with "processes" or "relationships"?

"Recently, deep neural networks (DNNs) have emerged as powerful tools for synthesizing high-dimensional geoscience data, leveraging because of their formidable ability to capture complex nonlinear mapping capabilities"

We agree. We have reworded the sentence using "relationships".

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*The relevant sentences have been revised appropriately to adapt to this:*

*"Recently, deep neural networks (DNNs) have emerged as powerful tools for synthesizing high-dimensional geoscience data, because of their formidable ability to capture complex nonlinear mapping relationships."*

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L76 - It's not clear what "Their" is referring to. I think you should restate to "The effectiveness of DNNs"

Figure S4.2 - please reduce the precision of the error variances to the nearest whole unit (i.e. 2668 not 2668.22)
