

Editor's comments on Oct. 21:

Dear Authors,

I think that you have addressed most of the Reviewers' comments sufficiently; however, there are still some issues that require more attention before I can recommend final acceptance. I concur with Reviewer 1 that the English use and style need improvement, and I urge you to take this into serious consideration, e.g., by having a professional proofread of your manuscript. There are also some issues with the Figures. Please use consistent panel labelling (a, b, c,) (e.g. Fig. 5 and 9), instead of pointing "left/right" "top/bottom" in the caption. Check the figures for labelling, etc. Current annotations of the axes are almost illegible - e.g. in Fig. 5.
