I want to thank the authors for addressing my concerns adequately. The revised Section 4 has improved tremendously. I still have a few minor comments that should be easy to address.

- Line 63: I suggest explicitly mentioning global temperature 'anomalies' here as well.
- Line 110: I suggest explicitly mentioning that the alkalinity used here is represented by carbonate alkalinity and not total alkalinity (including several other proton donors/acceptors) as is used in more complex models.
